### WHAT TO DO PRIOR TO TECHNICIANS ARRIVAL\*

- Remove all leaves and debris from the pool. Pool cleaning is not included as part of the closing service.
- Lower water level to mid skimmer
- Ensure power is on at the pool equipment and that a water source is available.
- Have the pool cover poolside. Any damaged plugs, gizmos, stakes, anchors, water bags, or blowout extensions will be replaced as needed and billed accordingly.

We will not enter your shed, garage, or home to retrieve the pool cover unless discussed with office

If a return visit is required because the electric is off, the cover or closing items are not accessible, the homeowner will be responsible for an additional service charge, and the appointment will be rescheduled at our discretion.
